

Biosite coronavirus (COVID-19) visitor policy

In response to the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, we are putting precautionary measures in place to protect the health and wellbeing of our employees, as well as considering the welfare of the various parties that we may meet.

These measures are necessary and consistent with action being taken by other organisations all over the world. Please consider the following:

- Aim to conduct non-essential face-to-face meetings using remote facilities (i.e. video conferencing, telephone)
- Visitors experiencing flu-like symptoms (particularly a new, continuous cough, fever or respiratory discomfort), colds or non-chronic respiratory problems will not be permitted on site
- Visitors who are well but have a household member experiencing symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) – as above – will not be permitted on site
- Shaking hands or physical greetings are not permitted
- All people on site should regularly clean their hands with soap and running water for at least 20 seconds or frequently use suitable alcohol-based hand rub / sanitiser
- All people should try to maintain social distancing recommendations (keeping at least 2 metres distance from each other)
- Any paperwork should be completed electronically when possible. When this is not possible, paperwork should not be handed directly to another person, but instead placed on a surface where it can be picked up. Hands and surfaces should be cleaned and disinfected afterwards

In addition to these special measures, we request that our customers, visitors and suppliers make us aware of their own procedures and guidance implemented to preserve and protect the health of their employees and people on site, when possible.
