Supporting social distancing on site

The latest industry guidance* recommends restricting the number of people using communal facilities on site at any one time with the use of a welfare attendant. Such areas include toilets, changing rooms and showers but the guidelines could also be applied to any areas on site where social distancing measures are recommended; for example, entrance and exit points (in addition to normal security requirements) and canteens.

Biosite welfare attendants can support social distancing by regulating operative numbers in communal areas, with the added benefit of being able to monitor staggered shift patterns if required. Putting you in control of your site.
